

Kitchen Staff

Shri Jasnath Asan is seeking two full time kitchen staff members. The ashram houses 10 full time family members, plus many visiting Sevas from around the Marwar region. It is also a retreat destination for many yogis and vacationers from western continents including Europe and the Americas. The ashram employs several full-time people in the kitchen, grounds, and garden, to ensure that day-to-day operations occur seamlessly.

Job Description: This candidate rises early in the morning to participate in Karma Yoga chores with her sisters and brothers. She is consistently available to her family to help wherever it is needed to ensure the ashram activities are carried through gracefully, with a serene spiritual attitude that attracts smiles from all. The tasks of her official post includes (but is not limited to):

- Harvest, clean, chop vegetables from the garden
- Prepare dough for bread and make roti
- Clean equipment, dishes, floors, and all of kitchen
- Stocking and inventory management
- Serving and catering
- Laundry

Ideal candidate: This position appeals to the person who is independent, hard-working, self-starting, and willing to commit long-term to our ashram family.

- High work ethic and organization skills
- Attend ashram yoga class 2-3 times weekly, keeping fit and healthy
- English classes (formal and informal), striving to learn appropriate communication skills with visitors

Compensation & Schedule: This position comes with a private dharamsala room with community toilet/bath. All work related expenses including travel will be met by the ashram. The first three weeks are strictly Seva. Following this period and a successful work evaluation, a full-time position would be made available with a competitive monthly stipend and annual bonus based on performance. 1 month paid vacation in July or August.
